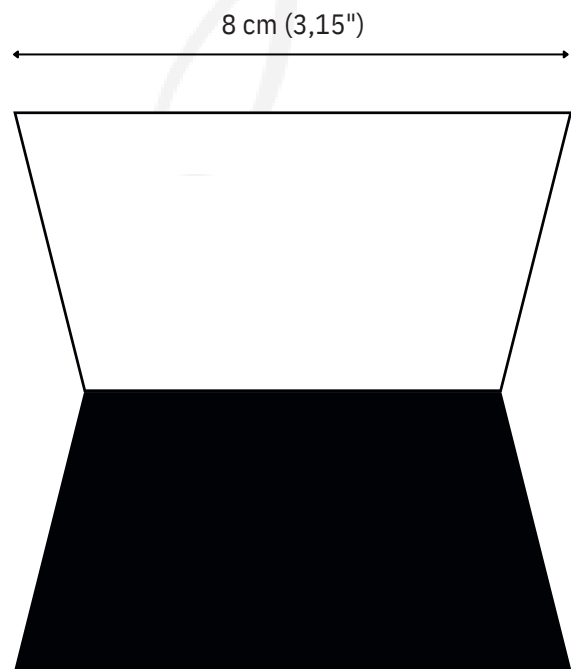

GUIDELINES



MUNARI MOBILE

The Munari mobile, with its contrasting black and white colors, is suitable to introduce to infants from birth. The distinct shades are age-appropriate and help in the development of visual pathways, offering benefits such as focus and concentration enhancement for your baby.

LET'S BUILD A BABY MOBILE!

GATHER YOUR SUPPLIES

Munari mobile templates: Print them out and grab some scissors.

Card stock (optional): Want to prevent curling? Add a layer of sturdiness!

Needle or pointed tool: Time to make some tiny holes.

Silk thread: Light and elegant, perfect for hanging your creations.

A clear glass ball (around 6 cm / 2.35 inches): Think ornament, not bowling ball!

Three dowels (ideally black, white, or plain wood):

- Dowel A: 14.2 inches (36 cm)
- Dowel B: 11.9 inches (30 cm)
- Dowel C: 7 inches (18 cm)

READY TO ASSEMBLE? LET'S GO!

Cut out the shapes: Grab your scissors and carefully cut out each template.

Mirror, mirror on the wall: Join the two pieces of each shape to create mirrored sides.

Glue or tape them together. Feeling fancy? Add card stock for extra support.

Poke a hole: Use your needle or sharp tool to create a tiny hole in each shape.

Building from the bottom up! Thread your silk thread and start assembling the mobile.

First, the rectangle

Then, the square

Followed by the circle

And finally, the glass sphere

Hang it up and watch your baby mesmerized!
